19th ANNUAL CONVOCATION OF THIRUVALLUVAR UNIVERSITY

The 19th Annual Convocation of Thiruvalluvar University was held on Sunday, 13th Oct, 2024, at the university campus. A total of 155 students received their degrees in person, including 86 PhD research scholars, 36 undergraduate students, and 33 postgraduate students. A total of 28,262 students were awarded degrees in absentia.

The Annual Report for the academic year 2023-2024 was presented by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. T. Arumugam. The Chancellor, His Excellency, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, Shri R. N. Ravi, presided over the event and conferred the degrees. Honourable Higher Education Minister, Dr. Govi Chezhian, also graced the event. The Chief Guest, Prof. Dr. Tusar Kanti Behra, Director of ICAR-Indian Institute of Horticultural Research, Bengaluru, delivered the Convocation Address. The event was attended by various dignitaries including, Syndicate and Academic Council members, the Registrar, and the Controller of Examinations. Following the ceremony, the Governor and the Higher Education Minister visited the university's Online Digital Valuation System.
